

ORDINANCE NO. 11072022A

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 9-1,
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF EATON,
BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF EATON, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN THAT CHAPTER 9-1, BE CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following ordinance Chapter 9-1 is adopted to maintain the peace and good order of the Town. The penalty for commission of such offense hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture, assessment and costs imposed by this Municipal Code.

Disorderly Conduct with a Motor Vehicle

(a) Conduct Prohibited. No person shall, within the County of Brown, by or through the use of any motor vehicle, including, but not limited to, an automobile, truck, motorcycle, mini-bike, or snowmobile, cause or provoke disorderly conduct with a motor vehicle.

(b) Definition. Disorderly conduct with a motor vehicle shall mean, while operating or in control of a motor vehicle, to engage in conduct or activities which are violent, unreasonably loud, dangerous to persons or property, or otherwise against the public peace, welfare, and safety, including but not limited to unnecessary, deliberate, or intentional spinning of the wheels, squealing of the tires, revving or racing of the engine, blowing of the horn, causing the engine to backfire, or causing the vehicle, while commencing to move or while in motion, to raise one or more wheels off the ground. Specifically excluded from this definition are legitimate, scheduled racing events.

(c) Penalty. Any person found guilty of violating this section, or any part thereof, may be required to forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$200, and the cost of prosecution, for the first offense, and not less than \$50 nor more than \$300, and the cost of prosecution, for the second or subsequent violation within two years, and upon failure to pay said forfeiture, and the costs, may be confined in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 10 days for the first offense and 30 days for the second offense, or until the payment of said forfeiture and costs is made.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
