

ORDINANCE NO. 11072022F

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 9-6,
OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF EATON,
BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF EATON, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN THAT CHAPTER 9-6, OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAW SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE BE REPEALED AND RECREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following statutes following the chapter 9-6 defining offenses against the peace and good order of the State are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the Town, provided the penalty for commission of such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture, assessment and costs imposed under Section 23 of this Municipal Code. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this chapter. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Chapter.
